

Comparison between Bossbridge and existing IR dongle solution (for B&O products)

Feature	Bossbridge	IR dongle	
PS3 buttons supported	51 (all)	25	(Bossbridge supports all command from the original Sony PS3 Bluray remote)
Poweron	Yes	No	(Bossbridge makes it possible to turn on the PS3 using the remote)
Poweroff	Yes (automatic)	Yes (manual)	(Bossbridge turn offs the PS3 using a single remote button press (macro))
Powertracking	Yes	No	(Bossbridge keeps tracks of the power state of the PS3, and acts accordingly)
Macros	Yes (10)	No	(Bossbridge allows for custom defined macros, one single remote button press executes a series of commands)
Upgradable	Yes (by USB)	No	(Bossbridge is upgradable by USB, for future features/functionality)
IR input	Yes	Yes	(Direct input for IR remote control commands on the front of the device)
PUC input	Yes	No	(Bossbridge has a 3,5mm Jack connector for direct PUC connection with a TV (no IR blaster is needed on the front))
Placement	Within 10m of PS3	In USB port of PS3	(Bossbridge connects using Bluetooth (wireless) to the PS3, allowing for flexible placement options)
