Quickstart Guide (B&O IR remotes)

BOSSBRIDGE / PS3 - Bluetooth pairing

Make sure the BOSSBRIDGE is completely turned off, if batteries are used remove these also. Turn on your PS3 system and use your PS3 controller to select the following option:

Settings > Accessory Settings > Register BD Remote

Power on the BOSSBRIDGE by connecting the DC adaptor. When power is applied, the red LED will start flashing to indicate that the pairing sequence has been initiated (the autopairing sequence is initiated during the first 20 seconds after poweron).

Within a few seconds the PS3 screen changes to Registering.

Now the BOSSBRIDGE is paired with the PS3!

Setting up a Beo4 remote

BOSSBRIDGE accepts 38kHz IR signals, and can therefore be controlled with a Beo4 using the PUC output found on most modern B&OTVs.

Make sure the STB list on the TV has been updated, then choose "**Sony PS3 RE-BL**" in the list (if "**Sony PS3 RE-BL**" is not in the STB list, the TV must be updated by a certified B&O technician).

Connect the BOSSBRIDGE to the PUC output using the supplied cable with 3,5mm jack-connectors, or use an IR Blaster and place the IR head on the front window of the BOSSBRIDGE.

Setting up a Beo5 remote

BOSSBRIDGE accepts 38kHz IR signals, and can therefore be controlled directly by a Beo5 IR remote, with the appropriate XML file and the Beo5 configuration tool.
